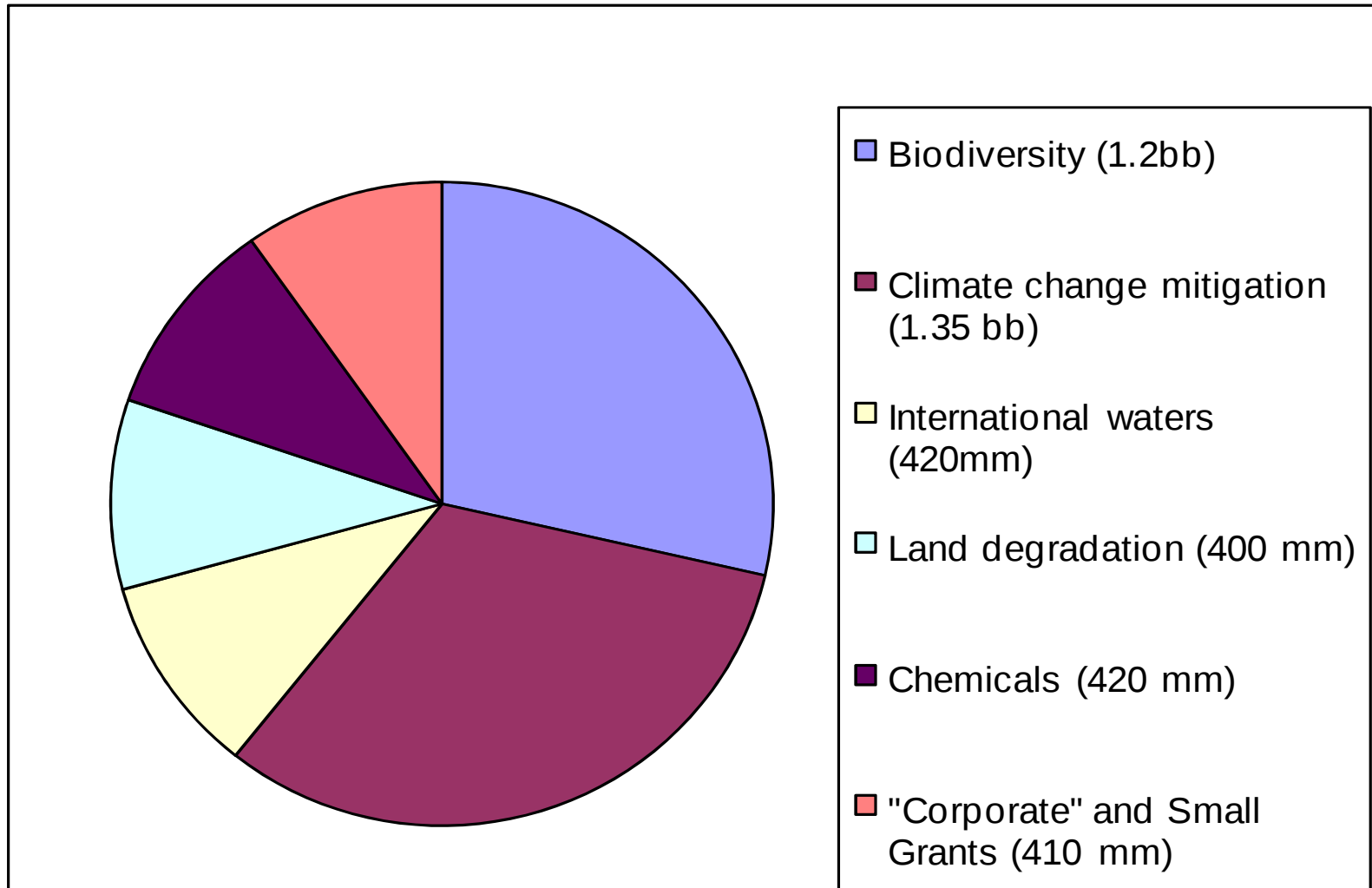

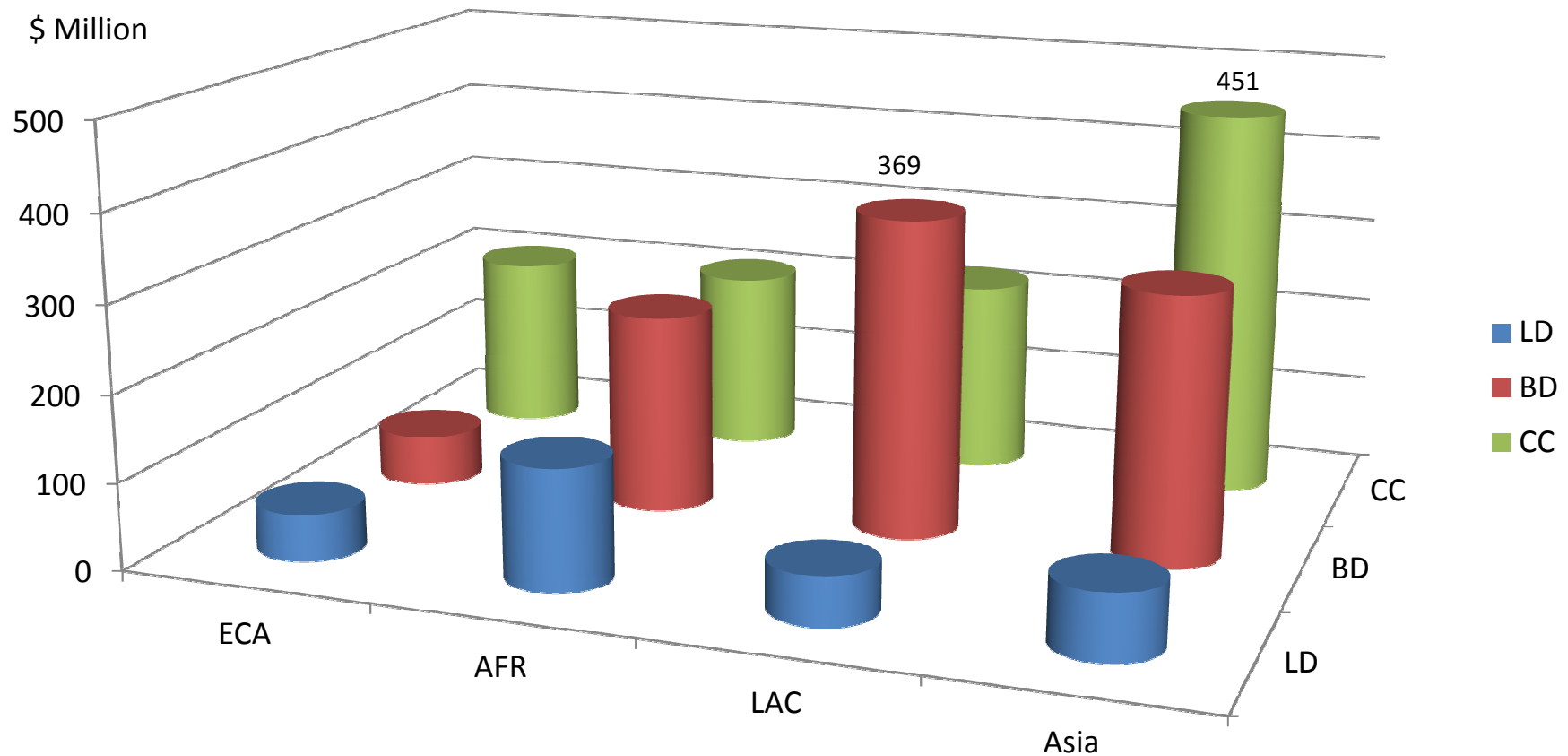

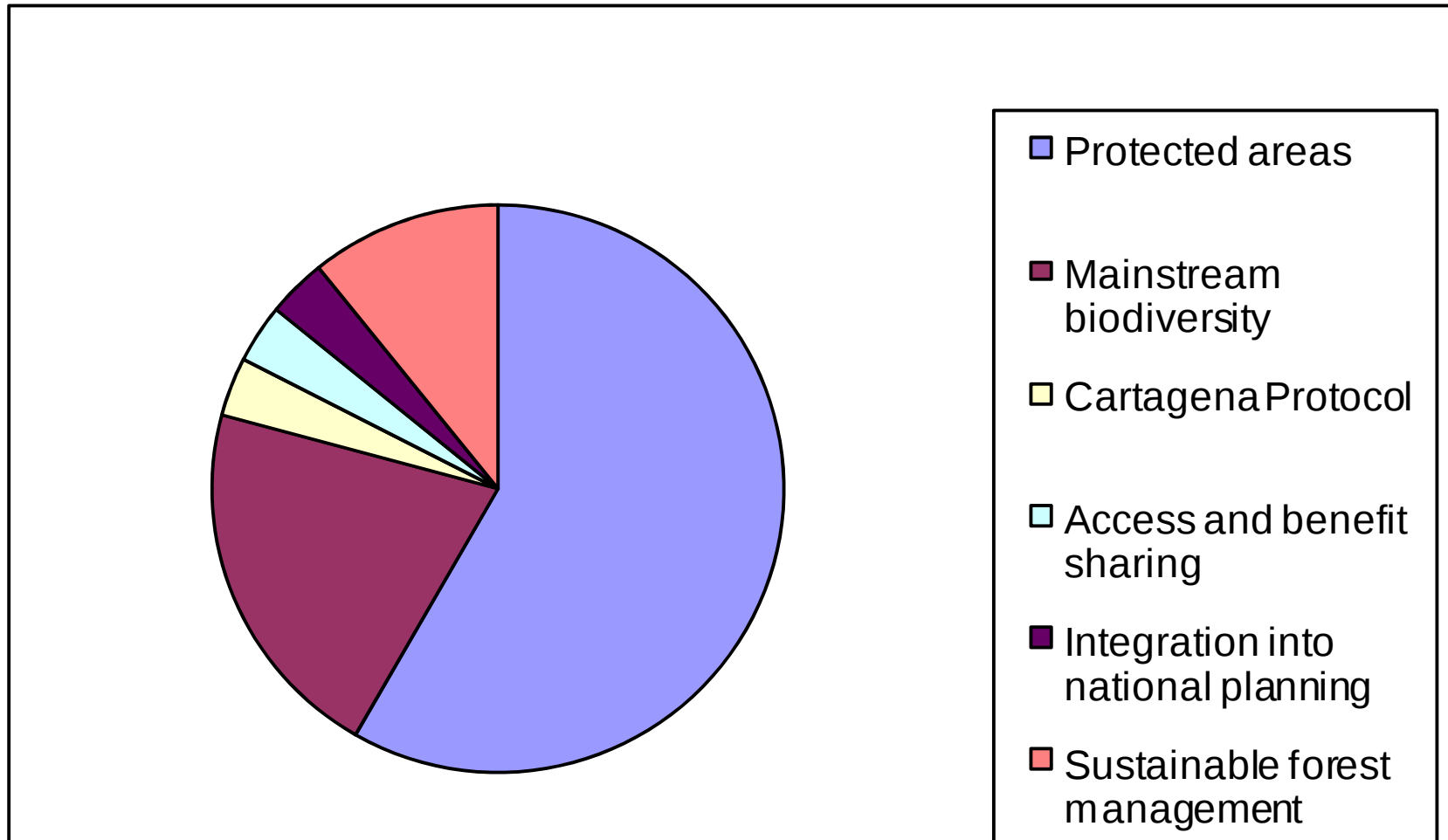
Distribution of GEF-5 Resources

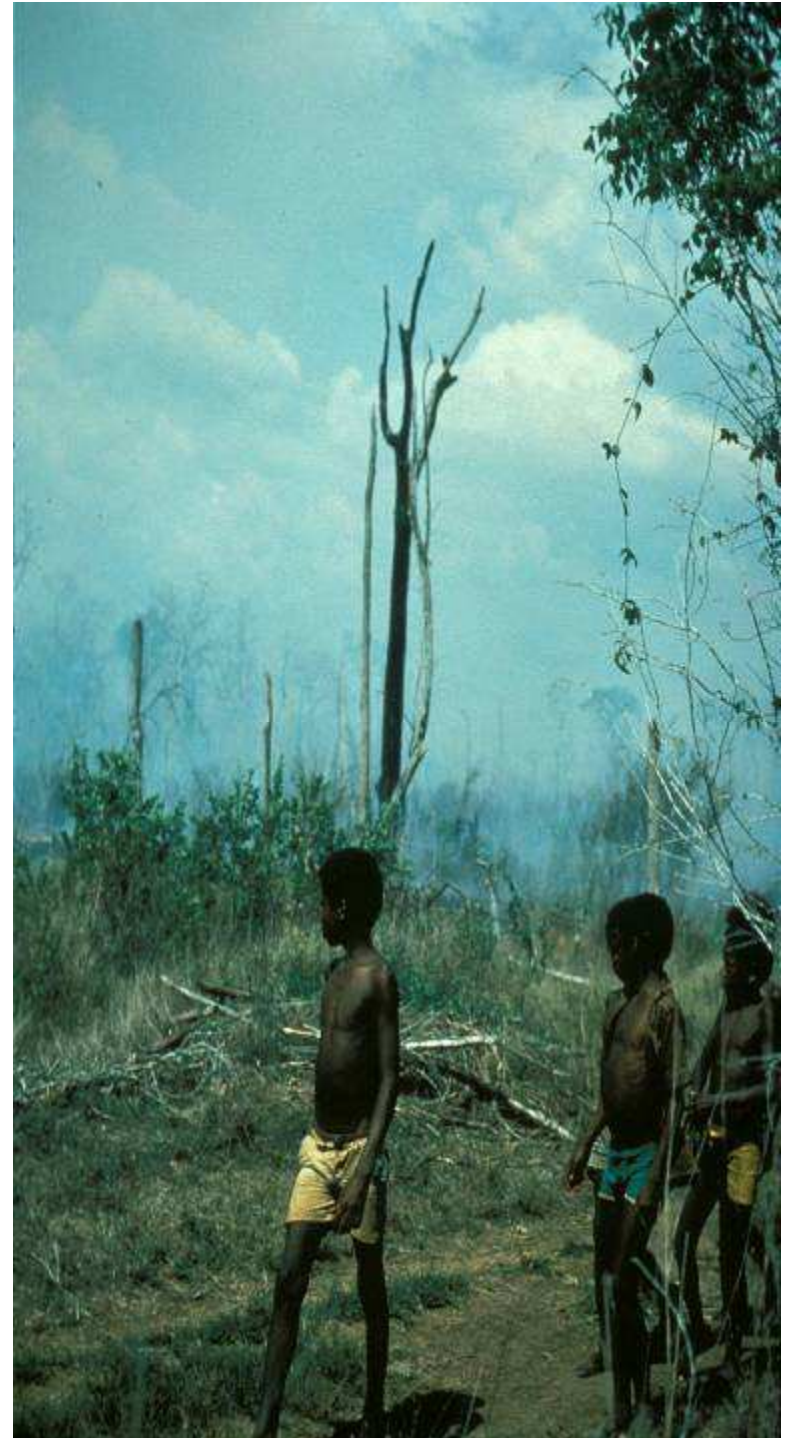

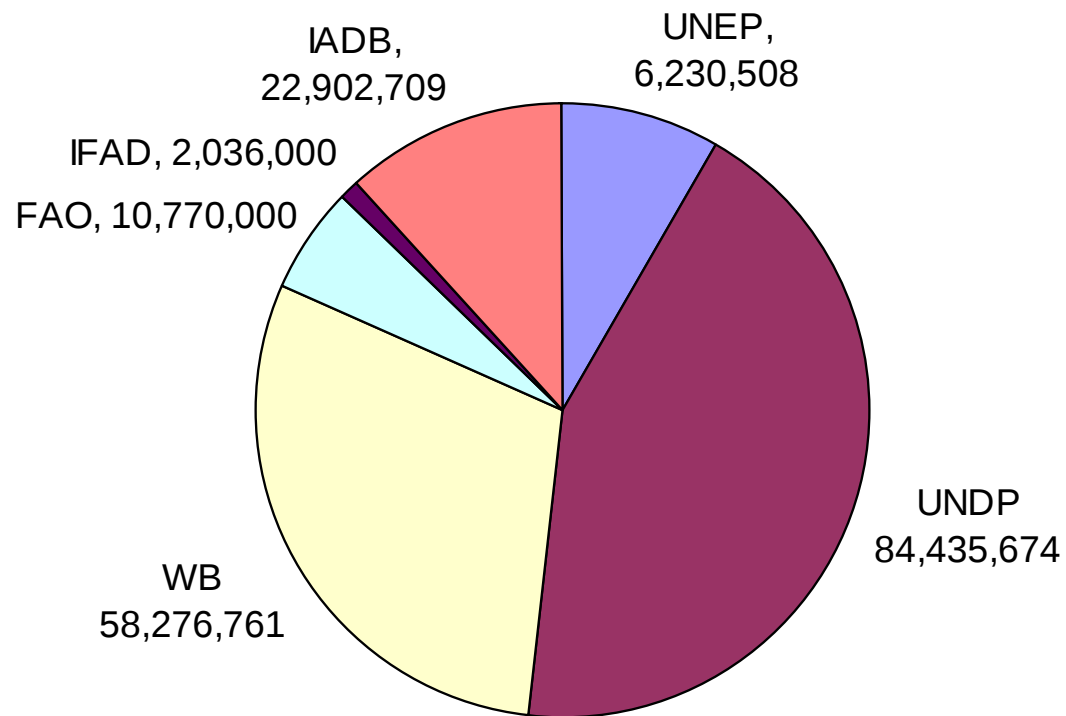

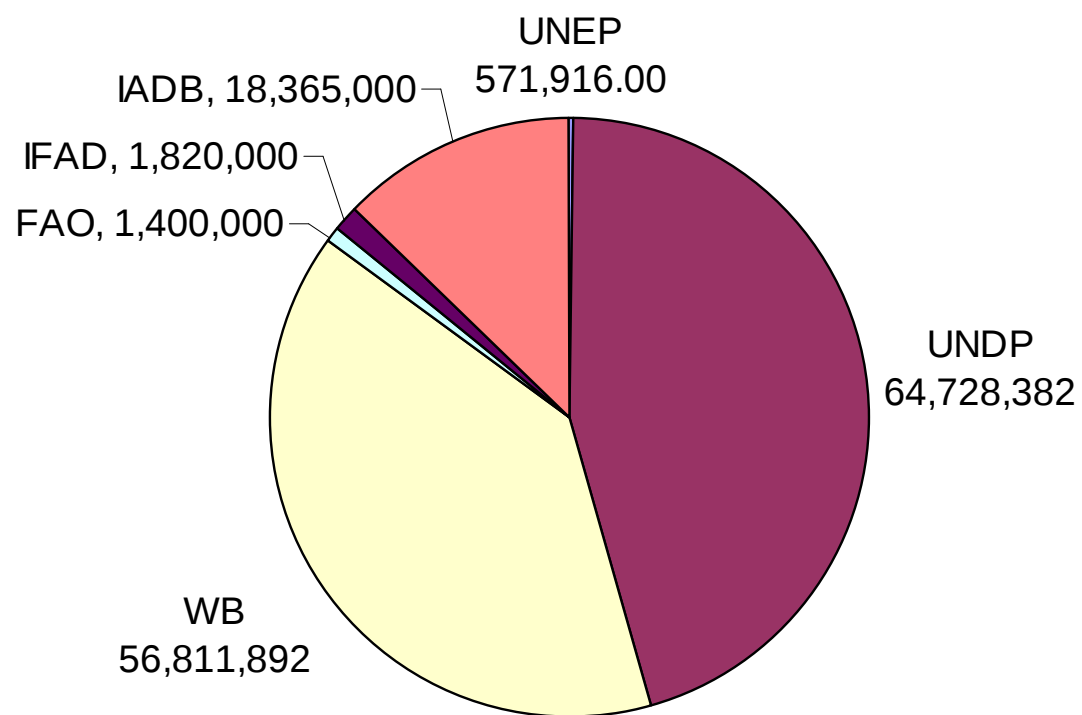
