

5. General information on access to Isle of Vilm



The Isle of Vilm is located about 300 km from Berlin or Hamburg. It will be necessary for delegates to travel by train to Lauterbach/Mole, the harbour village close to Vilm from either Berlin or Hamburg Airports. From Lauterbach/Mole you must then take a ferry to the Isle of Vilm. From the Lauterbach/Mole station, you can walk to the pier where the ferry boat to the Isle of Vilm departs.

6. Visa information



Participants from countries listed in **annex A** below require a Schengen entry visa for Germany and are strongly advised to contact the nearest German diplomatic or consular mission

as soon as possible in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.
