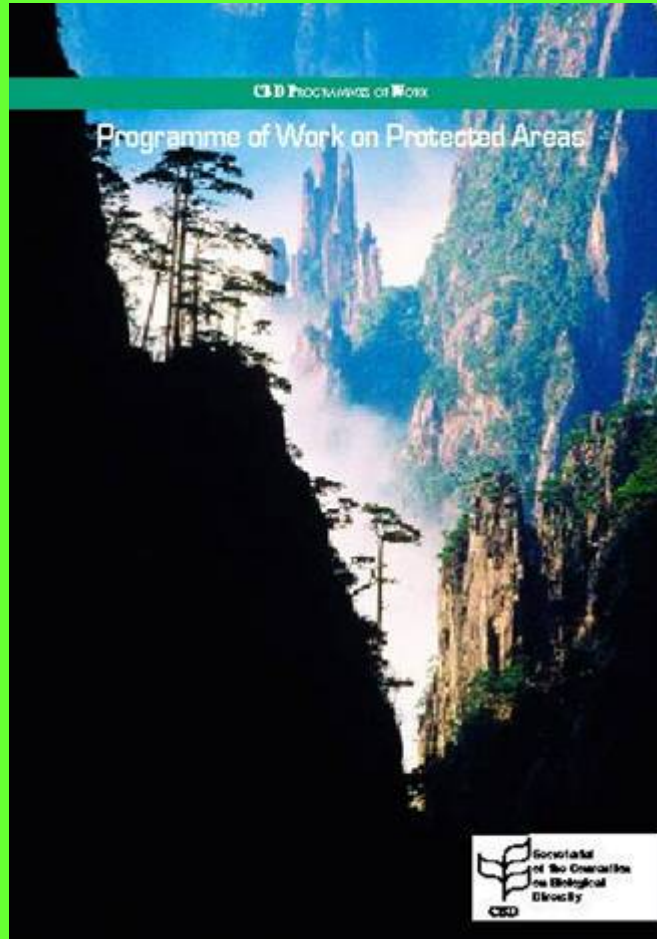

# PoWPA -- Potential

- Partnerships aligning activities to PoWPA targets
- Address obstacles (legal, financial, technical) to implementation
- Enhanced capacity and technical assistance
- Additional sources of funding to support implementation
- Assess progress in implementation
- Sharing experience and lessons learned at ecoregion and global level via the CBD.



# 2006 Regional Workshops



- 290 participants from 25 countries Government, NGOs, academic institutions, donors, civil Society organisations Private sector, indigenous peoples organisations

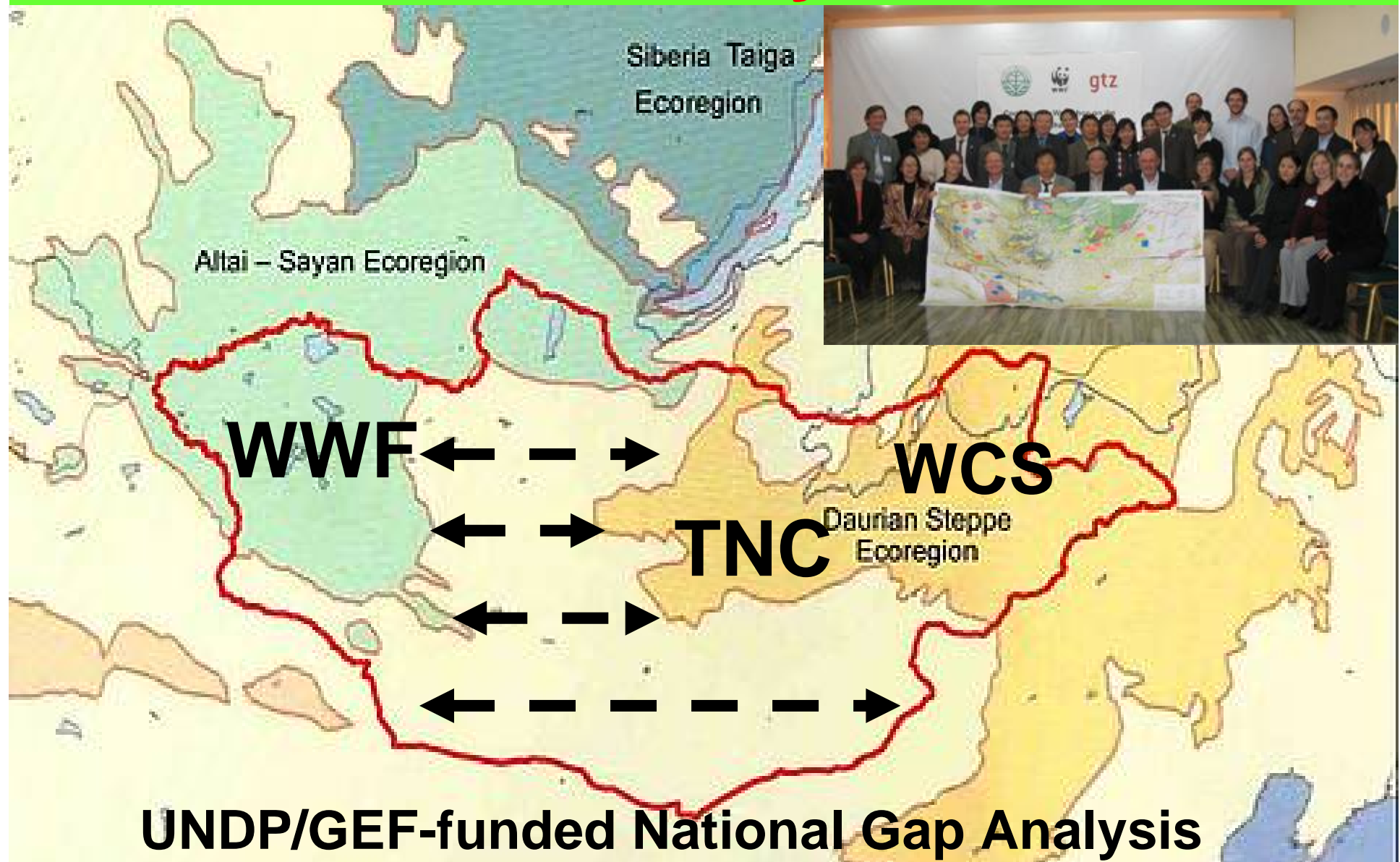

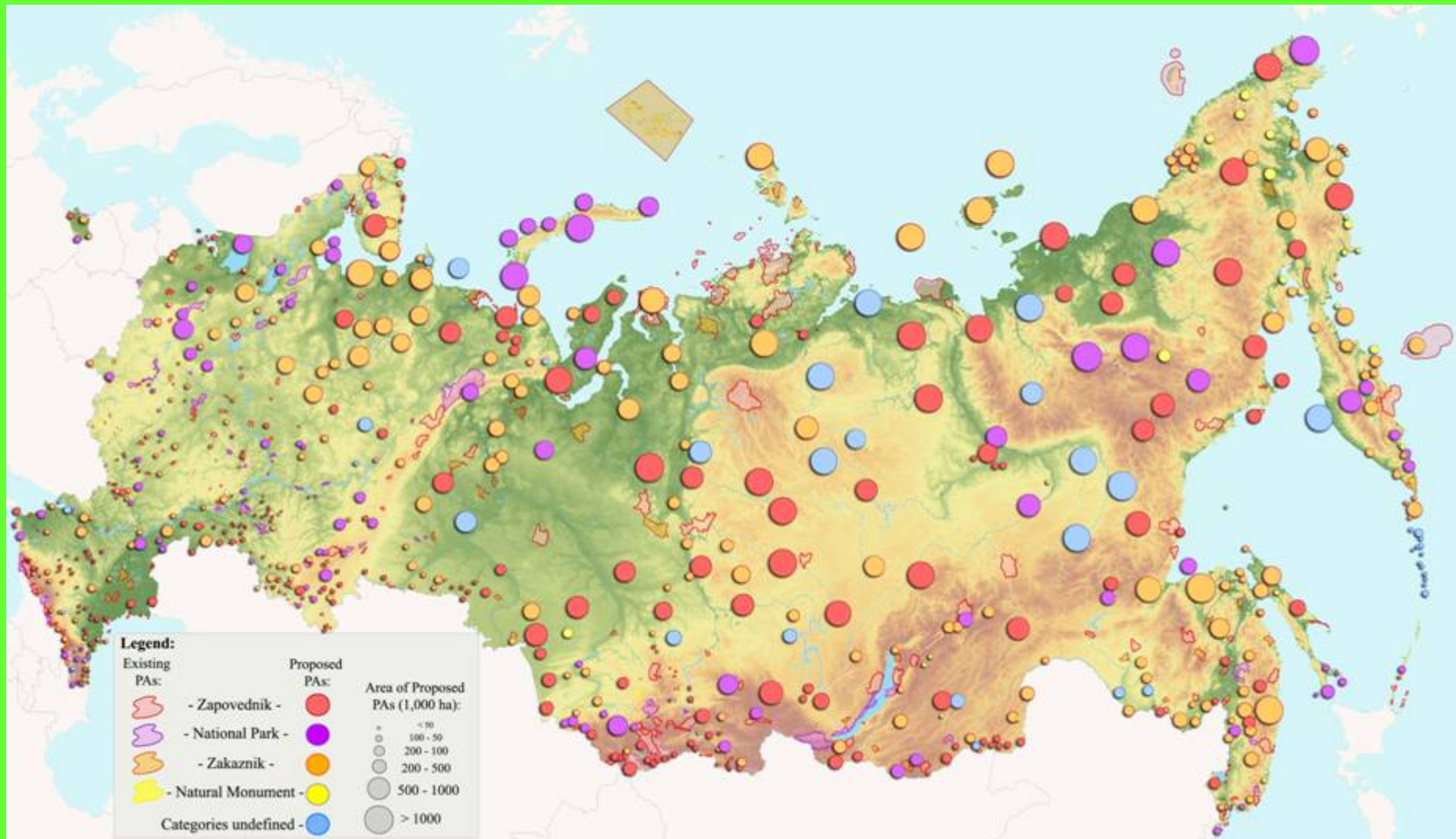

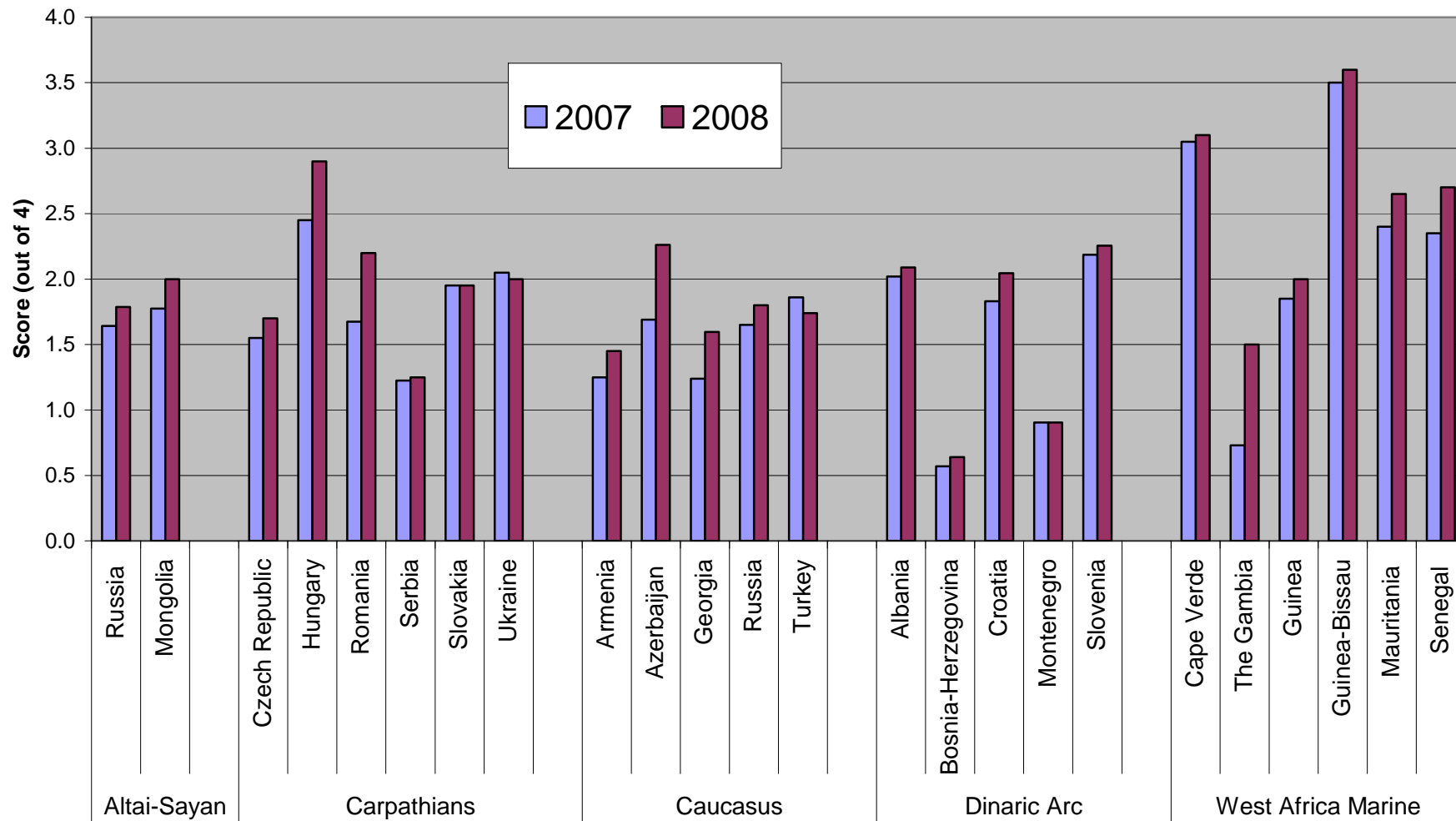
