• Voluntary commitments

Actions from actors other than national governments, especially the collective actions of indigenous peoples and local communities, women and youth, contribute to the attainment of the targets. However, it should be made clear that governments are still the actors with primary responsibility in implementing the GBF. Commitments by actors other than national governments are therefore voluntary and additional to this, hence in this document and related documents, we suggest referring to these commitments as "voluntary commitments" when they refer to those by actors other than national governments.

• Paragraph 7 of the addendum.

- We understand the need to align, where possible, with agreed indicators for the post-2020 framework. However, additional indicators could be relevant to assessing progress at the national level that could be outside these agreed indicators, and that are being developed by actors at different levels. Allowing such indicators and monitoring systems to be used in reporting voluntary commitments will be helpful in understanding how these ways of monitoring at the community/local level could feed into government processes. There is also a need to support the operationalization and development of monitoring tools where these do not yet exist or are not yet fully operationalized. We propose the following edits:
- 7. To avoid heavy monitoring and reporting requirements, measures could build on existing data gatherers and providers, using agreed indicators to measure performance against the post-2020 global biodiversity framework as well as indicators and monitoring systems developed by actors other than national governments, including indigenous poeples and local communities, women and youth. Where these do not yet exist or are not yet operationalized, technical and other means of support from relevant organizations and institutions is encouraged.
