ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

INTRODUCTION

1. The tenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties is due to adopt a revised and updated Strategic Plan of the Convention. In decision IX/9, the Conference of the Parties requested the Executive Secretary to solicit views from Parties and observers concerning the revision of the Strategic Plan. The Executive Secretary has prepared, in document UNEP/CBD/SP/PREP/1, an analysis/synthesis of views received which is available to this workshop. To solicit inputs to the revising of the Strategic Plan more widely, the Secretariat, together with partners and Parties, is organizing a series of regional or subregional meetings.
2. A workshop for Africa will take place in Cairo, from 11 to 12 December 2009. This workshop is organized with the support of the Regional Office for Africa of the United Nations Environment Programme and the ABS Capacity Development Initiative for Africa, which is being implemented by the German Agency for Development Cooperation (GTZ) on behalf of the German Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). The workshop will be held back-to-back with the fourth Pan-African ABS Workshop held at the same venue, 6-10 December, 2009.
3. The purpose of the Workshop is to provide an opportunity for participating countries to contribute to the elaboration of the new Strategic Plan for the period beyond 2010, including its vision, goals, targets and mechanisms to support implementation. The Workshop also aims to stimulate thinking about national biodiversity strategic planning beyond 2010 in response to the possible outcomes of the tenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties in 2010.
4. Participants in the Workshop will comprise government officials or experts from countries in the region who are participating in the 4th Pan-African ABS Workshop and who have been directly involved in the implementation of the Convention, particularly national biodiversity strategies and action plans. Participants should be in a position to provide insights and suggestions for the future implementation of the Convention. The nominee should also be in a position to help translate the goals and objectives in the revised Strategic Plan into specific national targets and measures while revising national biodiversity strategies and action plans, or other similar strategies and plans, in response to the revised Strategic Plan and revised biodiversity target(s).
5. The Secretariat has issued an information note for participants containing details of logistical arrangements including information on travel, visa requirements, accommodation and other matters for the workshop.¹ The languages of the Workshop will be English and French.

6. Registration of participants will be done on arrival at the hotel or at the venue of the workshop.

ITEM 1. OPENING OF THE MEETING AND OVERVIEW OF THE OBJECTIVES AND PROGRAMME

7. Representatives of UNEP and the Secretariat will open the meeting at 9:30 a.m. on Friday, 11 December 2009 .

8. The Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity will give an overview of the objectives, programme and expected outcomes of the workshop, and provide a summary of the process for the revision of the Strategic Plan.

9. The provisional agenda of the workshop prepared by the Executive Secretary is available as document UNEP/CBD/SP/WS/AFR/1/1. The proposed organization of work is provided in annex I below.

10. The emphasis of the workshop will be on exchange and active discussions. With this in mind, the workshop format features a mix of presentations with question-and-answer sessions, discussions in small working groups, and interactive sessions to provide inputs to the updated Strategic Plan. A list of documents for the workshop can be found in annex II below.

ITEM 2. BACKGROUND TO THE STRATEGIC PLAN

The current strategic plan, its implementation and progress towards the 2010 target

11. The Secretariat will provide background information on the current strategic plan of the Convention, an overview of the implementation of the Convention and progress toward the 2010 target, drawing upon information in fourth national reports and the analysis being undertaken for the third edition of the Global Biodiversity Outlook. Scenarios and their implications for the future of the Convention will also be outlined.

12. Participants will have the opportunity to present their progresses and challenges related to the implementation of the Convention, particularly the national biodiversity strategies and action plans. The Regional Office for Africa of the United Nations Environment Programme will also provide a regional perspective, as well as information on linking the thematic areas of UNEP's Medium-Term Strategy to the Strategic Plan of the Convention.

13. Following questions and answers, there will be a plenary discussion to identify the main challenges and opportunities facing the Convention for the post-2010 period.

Inputs and proposals for the updating and revision of the strategic plan beyond 2010

14. The Secretariat will introduce document UNEP/CBD/SP/PREP/1 presenting an analysis/synthesis of the views submitted by Parties and observers to date, including the outcome of a number of consultations.

15. A participant from the fourth Pan-African ABS Workshop will present some suggestions for elements of the new Strategic Plan concerning Access and Benefit-Sharing.

16. Following questions and answers, there will be a plenary discussion of the proposals made.

ITEM 3. ELABORATION OF A POSSIBLE OUTLINE AND ELEMENTS FOR THE NEW STRATEGIC PLAN

17. The Secretariat will introduce document UNEP/CBD/SP/PREP/2 setting out a possible outline and elements for the updated Strategic Plan, developed based on the views and inputs received so far, also taking into account comments from the Bureaux of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice (SBSTTA) and the Conference of the Parties.

18. Following questions and answers, there will be a plenary discussion focussing on options for the overall logic of the new Strategic Plan. There will also be a first discussion on a possible long-term Vision for the new Strategic Plan.

19. Subsequently, there will be sessions devoted to various components of the new Strategic Plan as detailed in annex I. There will be brief introductions by the Secretariat, Parties and observers, followed by discussions in plenary and small groups. Under this item, countries will also be invited to share their national biodiversity targets adopted for 2010 and beyond. Additionally, the Secretariat will introduce ideas for the revision and updating and implementation of National Biodiversity Strategies and Action Plans and the review of implementation by the Conference of the Parties. Parties will also provide their reflections on these matters.

20. Following consideration of each of the components of the new Strategic Plan, there will be an opportunity to review the work carried out, focussing in particular on balance among the three objectives of the Convention and between aspirations for outcomes and the means for achieving them.

21. Through plenary and group discussions, participants will consider how the post-2010 period can be designed to facilitate implementation of the new Strategic Plan.

ITEM 4. NEXT STEPS IN PREPARATION FOR THE TENTH MEETING OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE PARTIES

22. The Secretariat will brief participants about preparations for the tenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties, including key events leading to the tenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties and an overview of other events during the International Year of Biodiversity. The Secretariat will also describe the further steps in the process of updating and revising the Strategic Plan.

23. Following questions and answers, there will be a plenary discussion on how the opportunity of International Year of Biodiversity can be maximized for the benefit of the Parties and the Convention.

ITEM 5. CONCLUSIONS OF THE WORKSHOP

24. Participants will identify and adopt the main conclusions of the workshop on the basis of earlier discussions. The full report of the workshop will be developed later by the Secretariat and circulated to participants for their review before finalization.

ITEM 6. CLOSURE OF THE WORKSHOP

27. The workshop is expected to close at approximately 5 p.m. on Saturday, 12 December 2009.
