

5. General information on access to Incheon City, Republic of Korea



Incheon City is serviced by the Seoul - Incheon International Airport (about 25 km from the city centre) and the journey takes about 30 minutes. Taxis and buses are available at the on the arrivals level. Passengers can obtain information about Limousine and Premium Bus and purchase tickets at the following Bus Ticketing Offices: Exit 4 and 9 (indoors) & Exit 4, 6, 7, 8, 11, 13, and 9C (outdoors).

6. Visa information



Participants require an entry visa for Korea and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Korean diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

For entry into South Korea there is a limited Malaria risk mainly in the northern areas of Gangwon Do and Kyunggi Do Provinces and Incheon City (towards the Demilitarized Zone DMZ).

The official language in the Republic of Korea is Korean. English is spoken in some hotels and restaurants.

12. Weather and time zone information

The electrical currents are 220 Volts, 60 Hertz. The power plug used in Korea is only one type and is shown below.



14. Currency



The currency in the Republic of Korea is the South Korean Won (KRW). The current exchange rate as at 11 April 2011 is US \$1.00 = 1,086.07 KRW and $$\in 1 = 1,574.24$ KRW. Banknotes are available in 1,000, 5,000, 10,000 and 50,000 denominations.
