A new paragraph should be added after paragraph 12, *reading*

13. In paragraphs 18 and 19.6 of the final document adopted by the 14th Summit Conference of Heads of State or Government of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM), held in Havana in September 2006, the Heads of NAM States affirmed the role of South-South cooperation in the overall context of multilateralism and called for strengthening South-South cooperation, including through enhancing the capacities of relevant institutions and mechanisms, as indispensable means to promote and preserve multilateralism and the multilateral process. In paragraph 196 of this document, the Heads of State called on the international community to continue supporting developing countries efforts aimed at integrating the principles of sustainable development into their national development strategies and reversing the loss of environmental resources, including through the fulfilment of the 2010 biodiversity target.
