February is the rainy season in Salinas, with generally sunny days and heavy showers. The average temperature is 26-32°C by day and 24-26°C at night.

Telephone

International direct dial (IDD) and phone cards are available at the Barceló Colón Miramar Hotel Internet/E-mail services are also available.

Visas/Customs

All travellers must have a passport valid for at least six months before arriving in Ecuador. They must also have a return ticket to their country of origin or to another destination.

The consulate of Ecuador in Montreal advises that citizens of the following countries require a visa to enter Ecuador: Afghanistan, Algeria, Bangladesh, Costa Rica, Cuba, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Guatemala, Honduras, India, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Lybia, Nigeria, Pakistan, Palestine Authority, People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Syria, Tunisia, Vietnam and Yemen. It is important for participants to obtain visas from the Ecuador embassies/consulates before traveling. To enter he country, visitors must fill in an international embarkation - disembarkation form. It is important to keep it with your passport. Travelers should have their passports with them during their stay in Ecuador. A copy is not acceptable. Those who wish to stay longer in the country have to do the corresponding paperwork in an Ecuadorian Consulate. Please be advised that the Government of Ecuador has just informed the Secretariat of its intention to arrange for the issuance of visa at the airport in Guayaquil, Ecuador (except for the citizens of the following countries: China, Cuba, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Viet Nam and Panamá).

Airport Tax

A departure tax of US\$ 25 is payable by all departing passengers on international flights.

Official Language

The official language in Ecuador is Spanish.

Currency

Ecuador official currency is the United States Dollar.

Bank/Credit Cards

Most cash dispenser machines accept Visa, American Express and Master cards.
