Some benefits of a national coordination framework

Significant increase in efficiency and effectiveness of actions

- More coherent implementation of MEAs commitments at the national level
- Harmonization of positions to international negotiations
- Enabling environment to mainstream biodiversity into sectoral and national policies and development agenda
- Equitable distribution of resources to national priorities



Coordination framework

- Formal or loose structure, +government by in
- Comprehensive or thematic
- Technical – political (expert groups, inter-ministerial committee)
- Periodic or *ad hoc* meetings (*committees, dialogues, etc.*)
- Representativeness

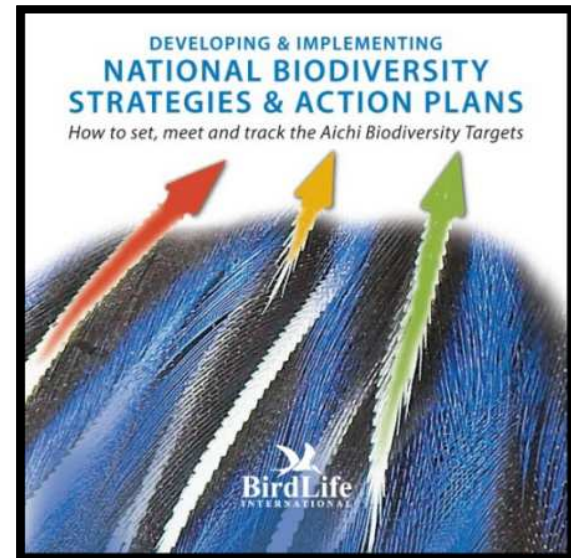
