Biodiversity Mainstreaming



This target focuses on the need to integrate the values and benefits of biodiversity into societal decision making. The full text of Aichi Biodiversity Target 2 states that: By 2020, at the latest, biodiversity values have been integrated into national and local development and poverty reduction strategies and planning processes and are being incorporated into national accounting, as appropriate, and reporting systems. Although biodiversity and ecosystem services provide enormous societal values, these values and benefits are not widely reflected or accounted for in

societal decision making, including in productive sectors, such as agriculture and energy, and in development sectors, such as land-use planning and poverty reduction. As a result, these and other sectors often have major negative impacts on biodiversity, underpinning the very foundation that sustains them. Furthermore, trends in biodiversity loss are often invisible in national accounts. In order to achieve this target, countries will need to assess the values of biodiversity to a variety of sectors, and to integrate biodiversity values fully into their national planning processes. While some countries will develop systems for natural capital accounting, they should also consider systems that recognize social and cultural values. Possible indicators for this target include trends in assessments of biodiversity values to key development and economic sectors; trends in the incorporation of natural resources, biodiversity and ecosystem services into national accounting systems, and trends in incorporating biodiversity into environmental impact assessments and strategic environmental assessments.

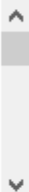

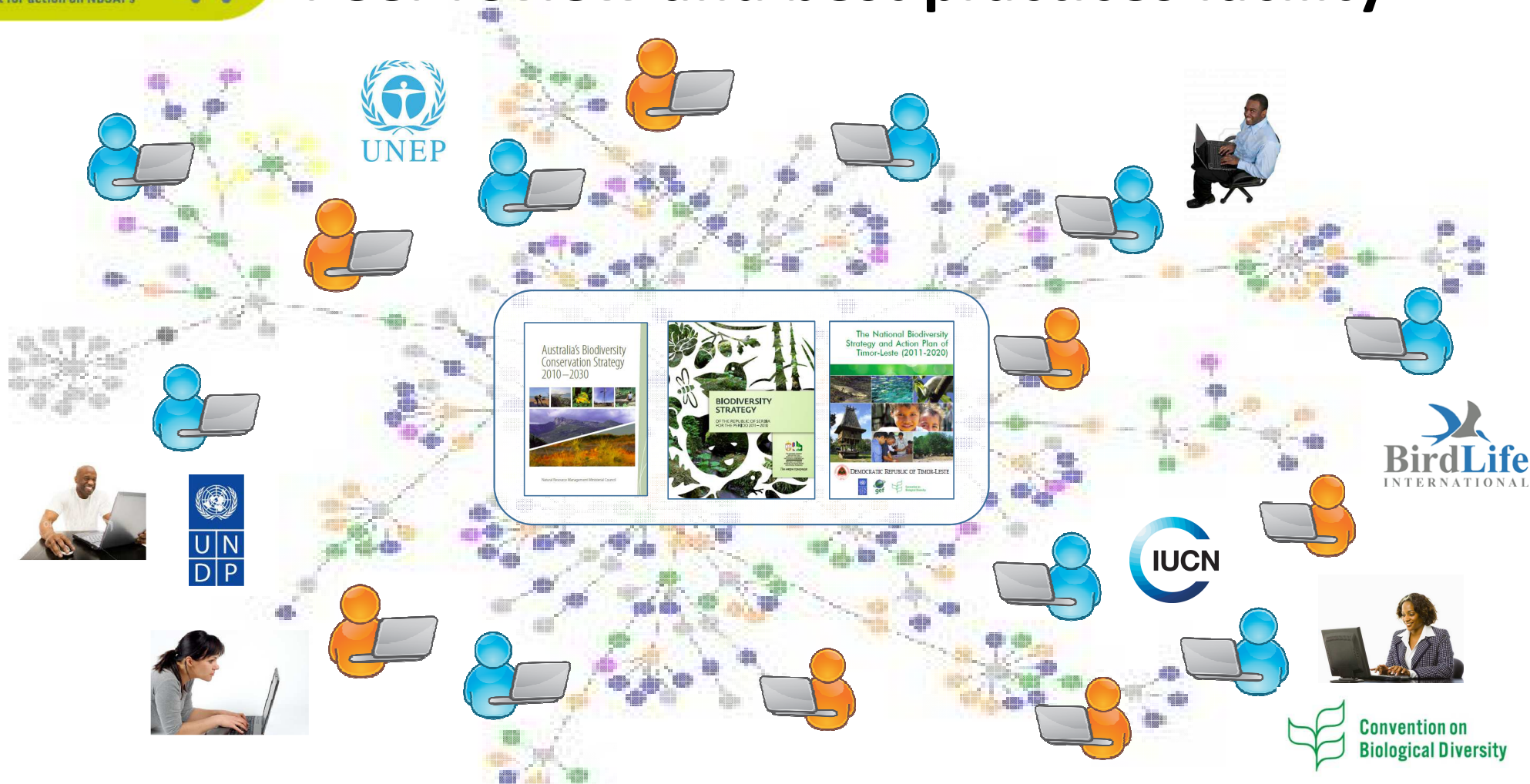
