NOTIFICATION

Informal Advisory Committee on the Biosafety Clearing-House Montreal, Canada, 9-10 November 2004

As you may be aware, Article 20 of the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety to the Convention on Biological Diversity establishes a Biosafety Clearing-House as part of the clearing-house mechanism under Article 18, paragraph 3, of the Convention, in order to facilitate the exchange of scientific, technical, environmental and legal information on, and experience with, living modified organisms; and to assist Parties to implement the Protocol.

At its first meeting, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Protocol (COP/MOP) adopted the modalities of operation of the Biosafety Clearing-House, which *inter alia*, noted that the Secretariat would seek assistance from an informal advisory committee. Pursuant to this decision, we are convening the informal advisory committee of technical experts on the Biosafety Clearing-House in Montreal on 9 to 10 November 2004.

I am pleased to convey herewith the list of invited experts. The composition was determined by the Secretariat taking into account the participants' demonstrated expertise and experience with the Biosafety Clearing-House, while ensuring regional and gender balance on the Committee.


