I have the honour to refer to Notification 2006-103 dated 2 October 2006 regarding the above-mentioned workshop which seeks to enhance the capacity of the countries in the region by sharing experiences on networking and information exchange, including new information and web-based technologies, with a focus on the special needs of indigenous and local communities.

In this regard, I am pleased to inform Parties and indigenous and local communities that the selection of participants to the workshop has been completed. The list of CBD/CHM National Focal Points and indigenous and local Communities applicants selected to receive funding is contained in Annex 1.
