Release of Guide to Business Related Events at COP-9

Business engagement is tabled for discussion at the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties (19-30 May 2008, Bonn, Germany) as a follow-up to the adoption, in March 2006, of the first decision, under the Convention, focusing on business.

The German Business and Biodiversity Initiative, implemented by the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Technische Zusammenarbeit (GTZ) GmbH, an initiative of the Host Government to mobilize business on biodiversity, will be profiled during the COP-9, including at the Expo for Diversity (27-29 May), during Expert Forums (27 May) and during the High Level Segment (29 May).
