Further to notification 2010-219, I am pleased to share with you the list of selected experts for the Ad Hoc Technical Expert Group (AHTEG) on Indicators for the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-2020, as contained in the Annex to this notification. The selection, made in consultation with the Bureau of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice (SBSTTA), was based on expertise, regional and gender balance, taking into account the modus operandi for SBSTTA and relevant guidance in decision X/7. All nominated experts, whether or not they are selected for the AHTEG or invited to the associated expert meeting, are also encouraged to participate in reviewing draft documentation prior to the meetings, as well as participating in the peer review of the meeting report.
