## NOTIFICATION High-level Segment of the 2018 United Nations Biodiversity Conference<sup>1</sup>

Further to notification <u>2018-061</u>, I am pleased to inform you that the draft of the "Sharm El-Sheikh Declaration – Investing in Biodiversity for People and Planet" is now available for comments.

The Declaration has a focus on mainstreaming biodiversity in the sectors of energy and mining, infrastructure, manufacturing and processing, and health, in the broader context of sustainable development and the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals. It is expected that the High-level Segment will adopt the Sharm El-Sheikh Declaration.

The Government of Egypt is circulating the draft Declaration through its diplomatic channels.
