The 2010 Biodiversity Target



"to achieve, by 2010, a <u>significant</u> reduction of the current rate of biodiversity loss at the global, regional and national levels as a contribution to poverty alleviation and to the benefit of all life on earth"

Decision VI/26 CBD Strategic Plan 2002

"that biodiversity decline should be halted with the aim of reaching this objective by 2010"

Presidency Conclusions of the EU Summit in Göteborg, 2001



World leaders agreed to several other important targets at the 2005 World Summit. I recommend the incorporation of these commitments into the Millennium Development Goals. This includes: [...] a new target under Goal 7: to "Significantly reduce the rate of loss of biodiversity by 2010".



Everyone in the world depends on nature and ecosystem services to provide the conditions for a decent, healthy, and secure life




Figure 2: Protected Areas as Proportion of Global Land Use 30 26.1% 23.4% % Global Land Area (148,453,304 km 2) 11.5% 9.2% 0.9% 0.2% Forest (1) **Protected Areas** Arable Land (4) **Permanent Crop** Urban **Permanent** (3) Pasture (2) (5)

- Activate the power of the conservation movement to work together towards a joint goal
- Broaden the constituency and resource base

- Demonstrate clearly what progress
 Europe makes in meeting the 2010
 biodiversity target.
- Gain maximum public attention across Europe for the challenge of saving biodiversity by 2010.



ICLEI LAB 5 steps to save biodiversity

- **1. Communicate:** public declaration by city leadership
- **2.** Assess: Development of Biodiversity Report
- **3. Plan:** Drafting and Consulting a 10 year BAP
- **4. Commit:** Formal Acceptance of BAP
- **5. Do:** Implementation of 5 Biodiversity Interventions until 2010








A success model in Europe

14 national governments signed Countdown 2010 Declaration 200+ partner organisations from local authorities, businesses and civil society **Target:** Upcoming EU Presidencies + Congress Hosts Subregional initiative: Caucasus

How can this look like?

- Austria: Federal Forests Enterprise has developed 4-year program to reduce its impact on biodiversity and to raise awareness.
- Belgium: Municipalities in the region of Limburg have 'adopted' endemic/endangered species.
- United Kingdom: the Ministry of the Environment has created a « Countdown 2010 Action Fund » for projects to save biodiversity.

Local and Regional Initiatives: Tilburg and Noord-Brabant

 Noord-Brabant has started a 10-year "crusade" for nature and landscape to improve environmental quality in the region.

 Tilburg improves regional development and planning through a "green template" process. An environmental cafe encourages public participation.






The power of the 2010 biodiversity target
