**Implementing the Addis Ababa Principles and Guidelines
for the Sustainable Use of Biodiversity**

WELCOMING that the *Addis Ababa Principles and Guidelines for the Sustainable Use of Biodiversity* (AAPG) are

- adopted by the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) at its 7th Conference of the Parties – COP7 (Kuala Lumpur, 2004),
- incorporated into the CITES work plan by the 13th Conference of Parties to CITES (Bangkok, 2004),
- adopted by the 3rd Session of the IUCN World Conservation Congress (Bangkok, 2004).

UNDERLINING CIC's significant contributions to the preparatory process of developing these *Principles and Guidelines* under the framework of the CBD.

AWARE of the need to further promote and implement the AAPG in the widest possible range; and

STATING that CIC strives to play an important role by bringing its experience in the field of wildlife management into the process and by advising the relevant government bodies and stakeholders during the implementation of the *Principles and Guidelines*;

1. REQUESTS the CIC President and the CEO to:
 - a. ensure that the AAPG are appropriately reflected in all relevant CIC policies, programmes and projects; and
 - b. advise CBD that CIC shall continue its cooperation in implementing the AAPG,
2. STATES that CIC Members, including Commissions and Working Groups, will support initiatives for the implementation of these sustainable use principles in practice.
