We realize that work on the proposals of the participatory process for the preparation of the global biodiversity post 2020 is based on the experiences of preparing the strategic plan 2011-2020; it should be continued and we believe that the plan must continue to be used as framework for the related treaties of the CBD, including biosafety and other issues related to the conservation of biodiversity because of its solid base elements. <u>Regarding the post 2020 strategic plan preparation process is relative, the gender issue must be prominently in this process which will lead to the adoption of the plan;</u> It will even issues of negotiation and advocacy for global biodiversity at all levels, building the capacity of the focal point in these areas to the effectiveness and efficiency of follow-up and implementation of the post 2020 plan.
