Project: Lessons learnt from incorporating the valuation of biodiversity and ecosystem services into the development of NBSAPs

Aim of work: **review** how ‘biodiversity values’ are being incorporated into NBSAPs and **create a roadmap** of good practice

Basis of the work:

Strategic Goal A of the Strategic Plan “Address underlying causes of biodiversity loss”

- Aichi target 1: increase awareness of the values of BD
- Aichi target 2: integration of biodiversity values into national and local development and poverty reduction strategies and planning processes + incorporation into national accounting and reporting systems

Project's approach (I)

Project will:

- **Examine** how the value of biodiversity and ESS and natural capital/environmental accounting are incorporated into revised NBSAPs
- **Assess** if incorporation of biodiversity and ecosystem service values:
 - **Helps highlight the contribution of biodiversity** and ESS to human and societal well-being, livelihoods and the economy
 - **Can effectively serve as a tool for mainstreaming** biodiversity across sectors, policies and programmes
 - => Supports Development of NBSAPs better suited to achieving Aichi Targets 1 and 2

Project's approach (II)

1. Online survey
2. Output of survey helps select six detailed case studies

Project's output:

Road map of good practice and lessons learned on integrated biodiversity and ecosystem service valuation into NBSAPs
