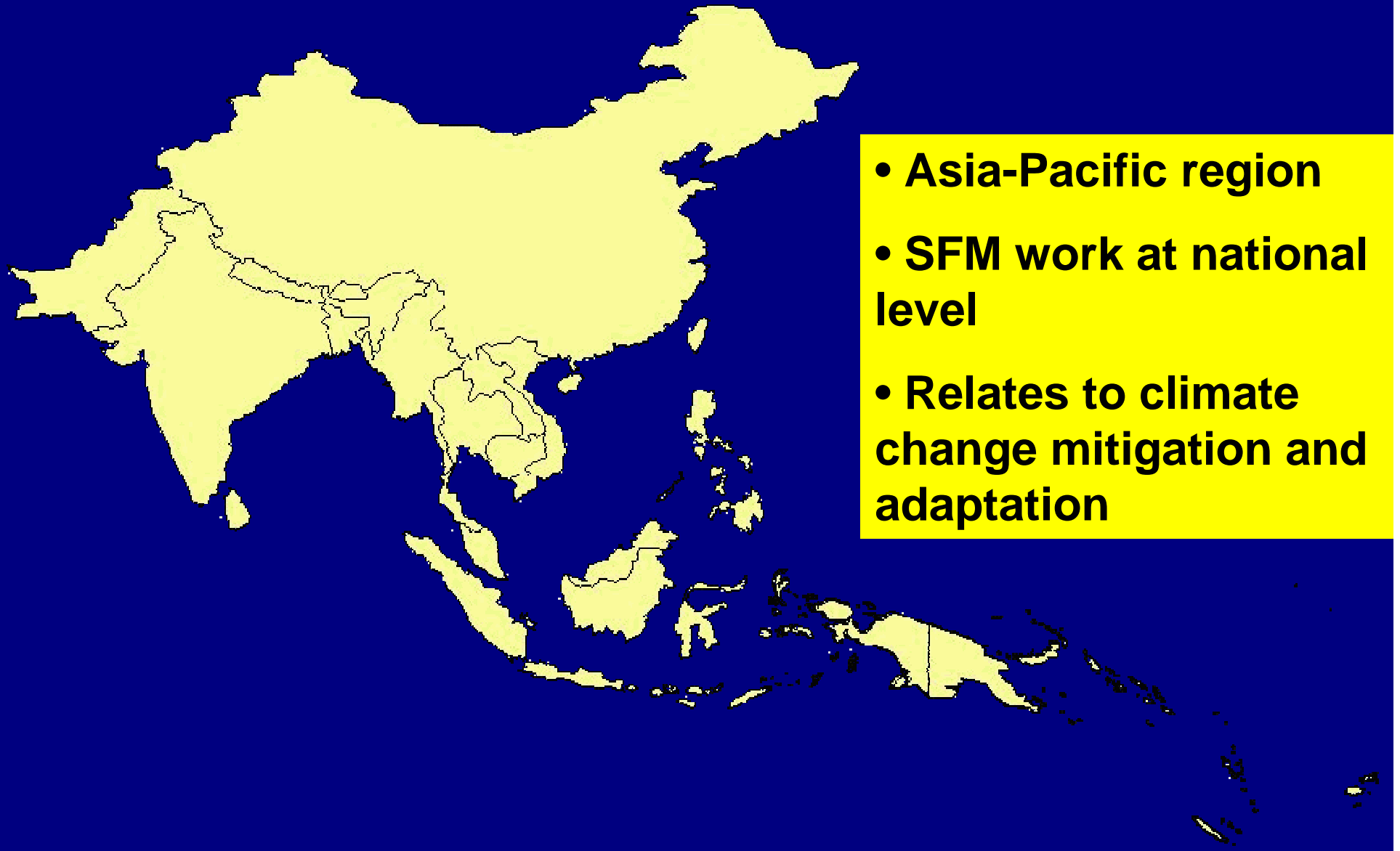

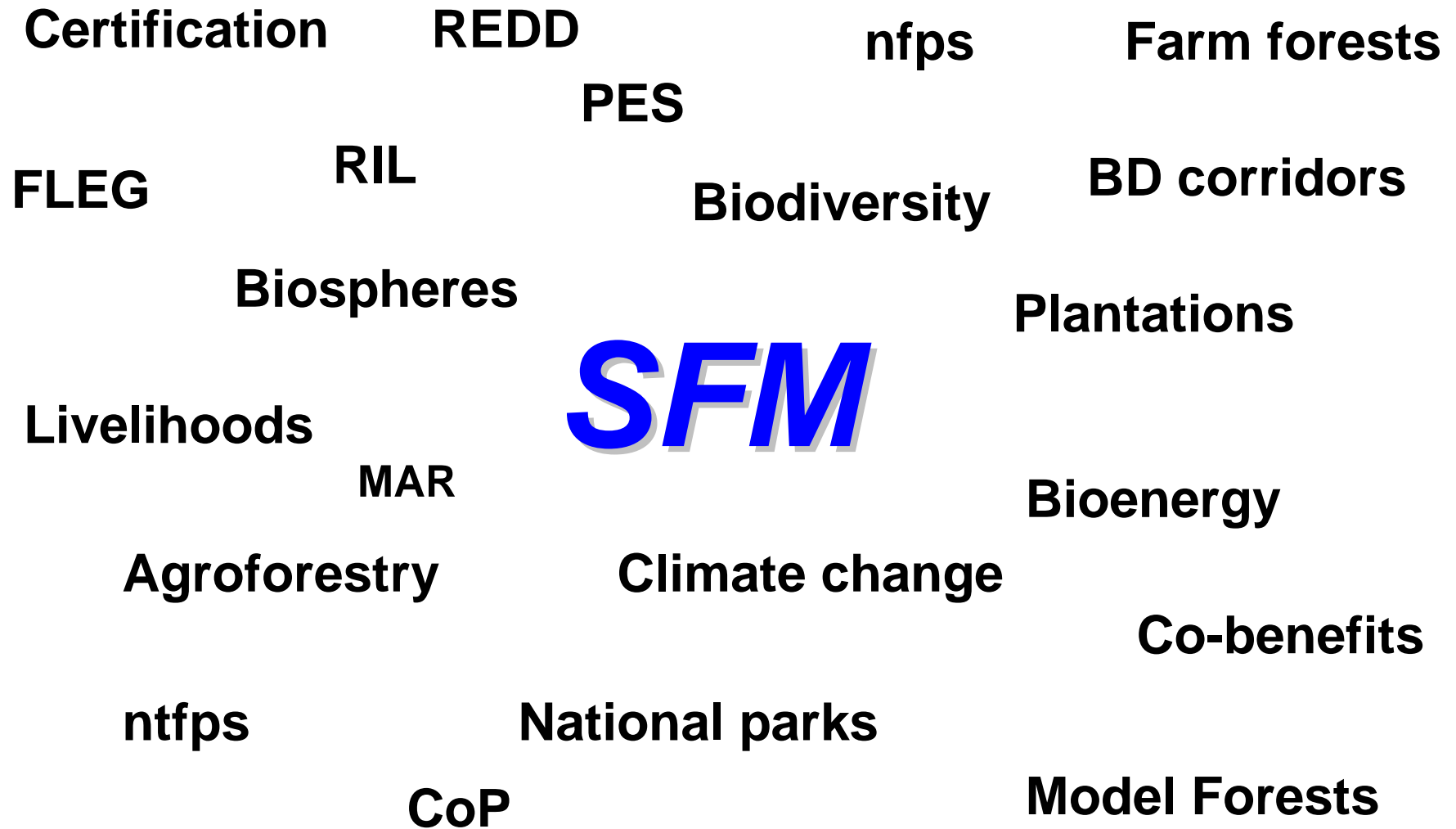
22nd APFC Session Recommendations 2008:

- **Guidelines** for national forest climate change adaptation plans



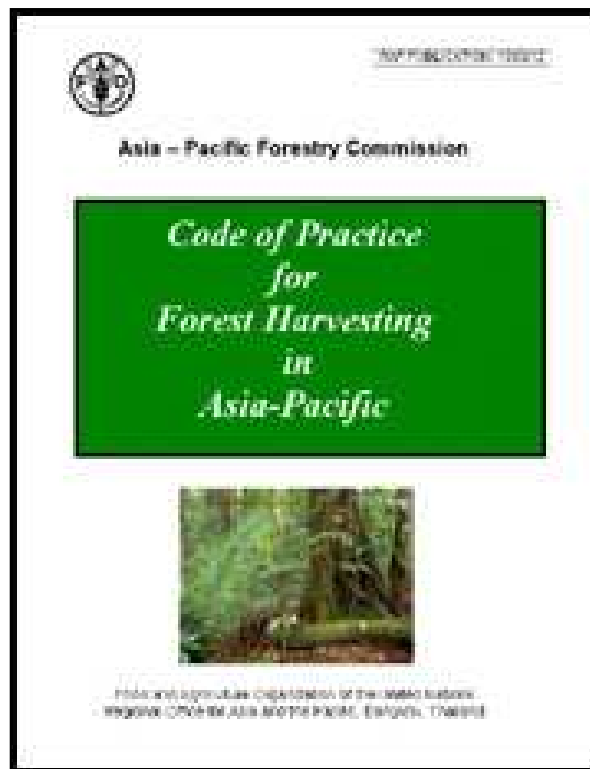

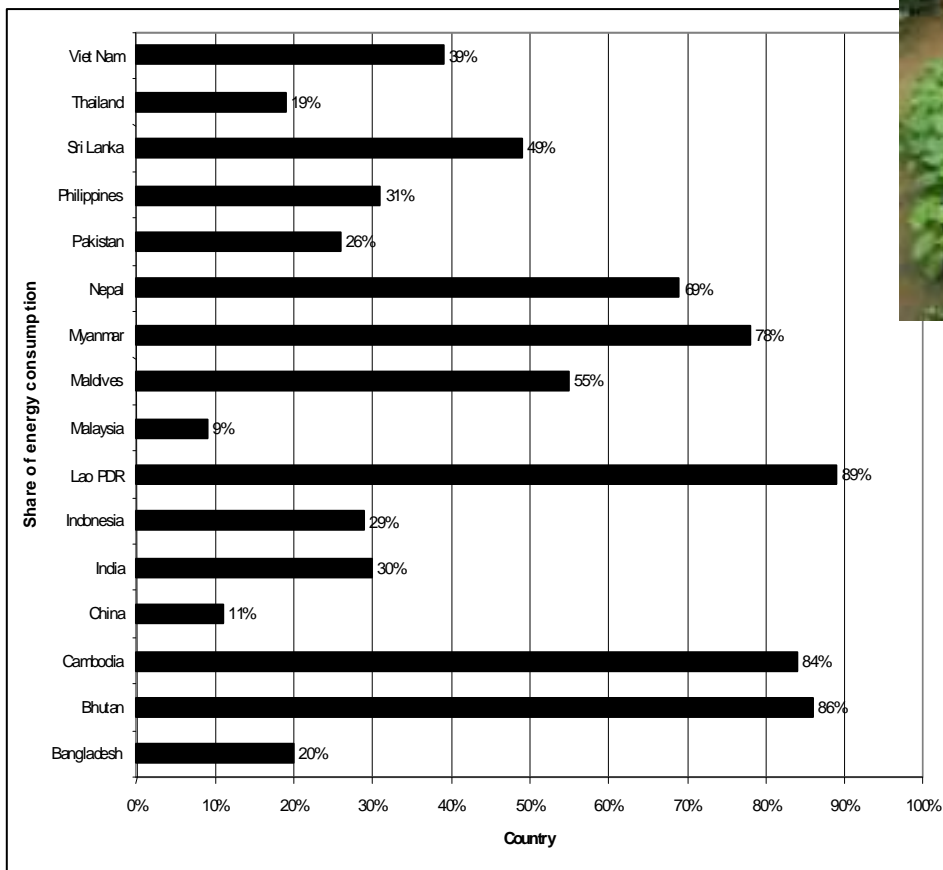
