

International Day for Biological Diversity 2022 Czech Republic

Special Radio Interview

On the occasion of the International Day for Biological Diversity a special interview was broadcasted on 22 May 2022 by the regional Radio Hradec Králove (region in the East Bohemia). The programme commemorated the 30th anniversary of the adoption of the Convention on Biological Diversity, the three objectives of the Convention and the importance of biodiversity for society.

The broad scope of the theme was underlined, connection with nature conservation, and environmental education, as well as the role of trees in the countryside and cities. In this connection, the European Landscape Convention was mentioned and its role in the given region of the Czech Republic, which is called the Czech Paradise and the part of which is included in the UNESCO Geoparks List.

On 19 May, the special interview on the same regional Radio was focused on trees, especially memorial trees of the given region and their role from the point of view of history, tradition and the environment. The programme was based on the publication "Památné stromy Jičínska (Memorial Trees of the Region Jičín)", which was officially presented to the public in March 2022.
