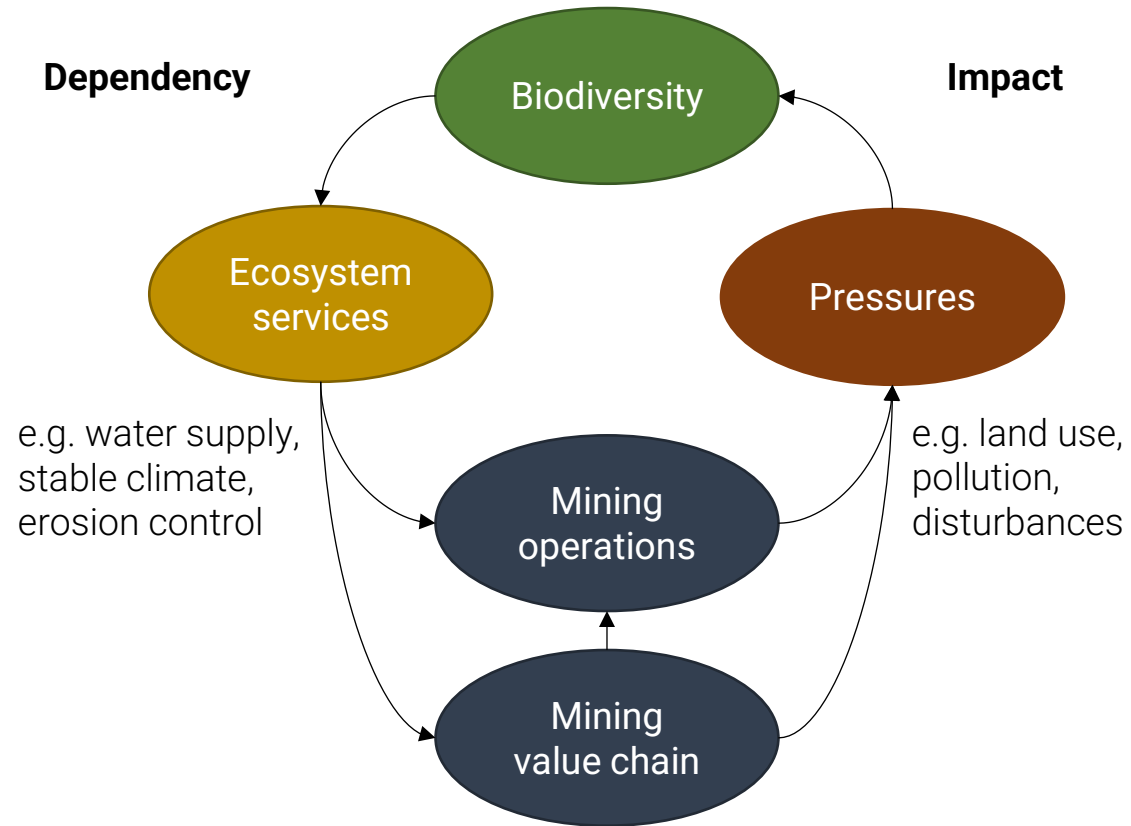

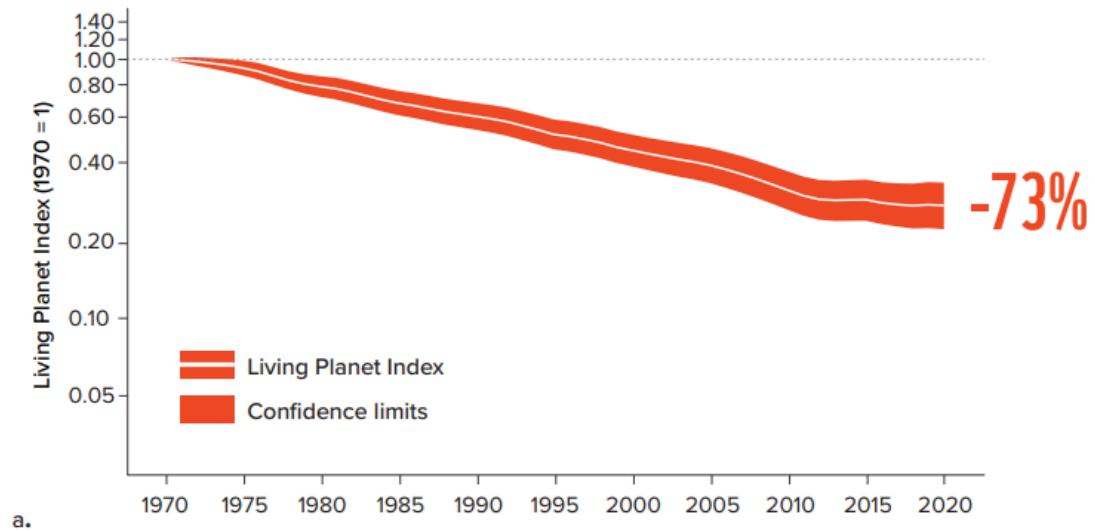

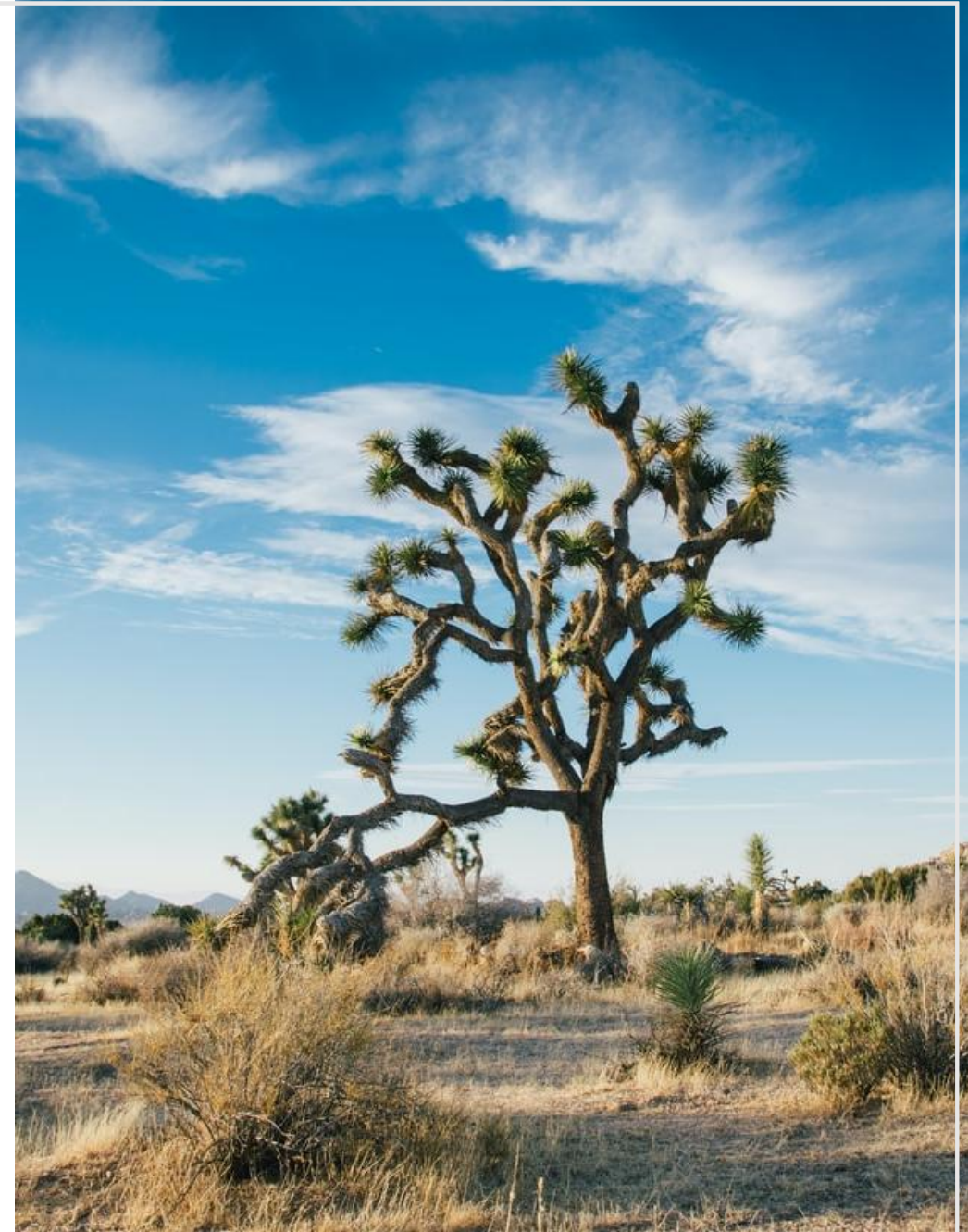


BIODIVERSITY IS DECLINING GLOBALLY

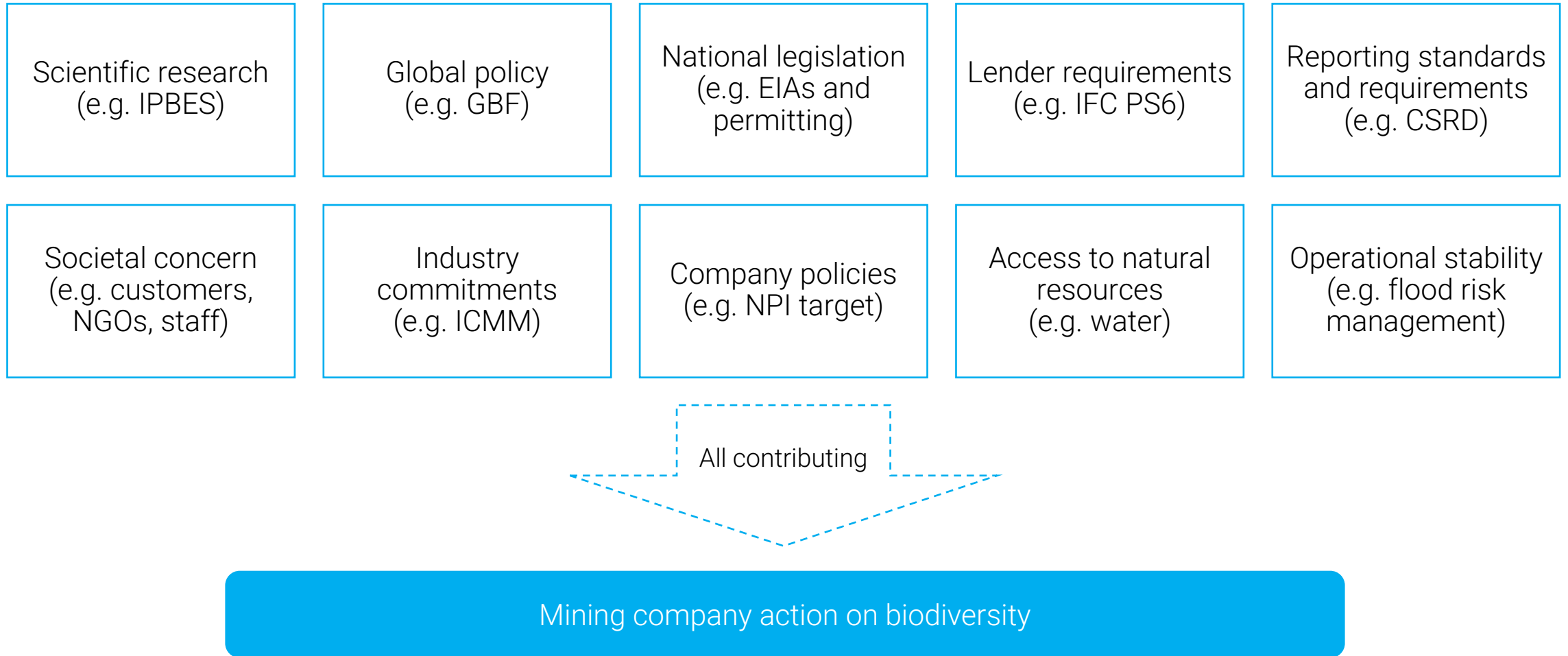
Global Living Planet Index



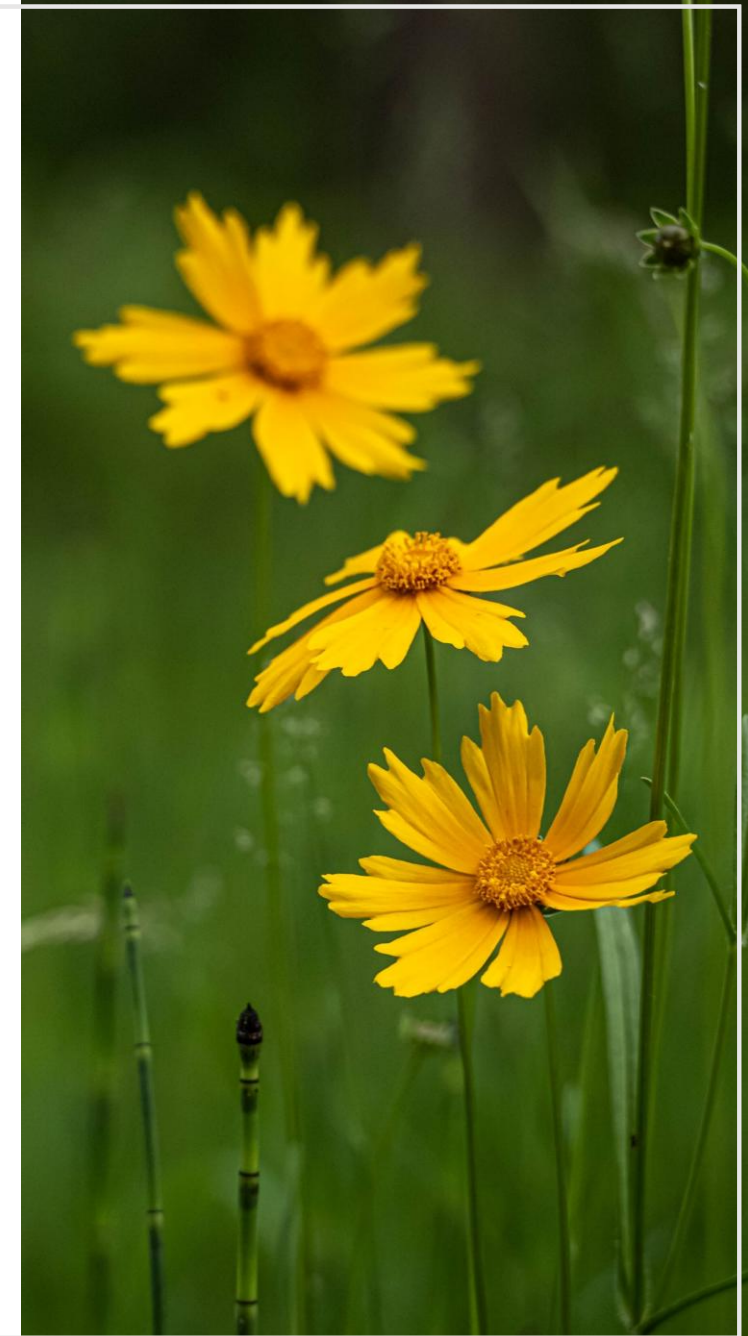
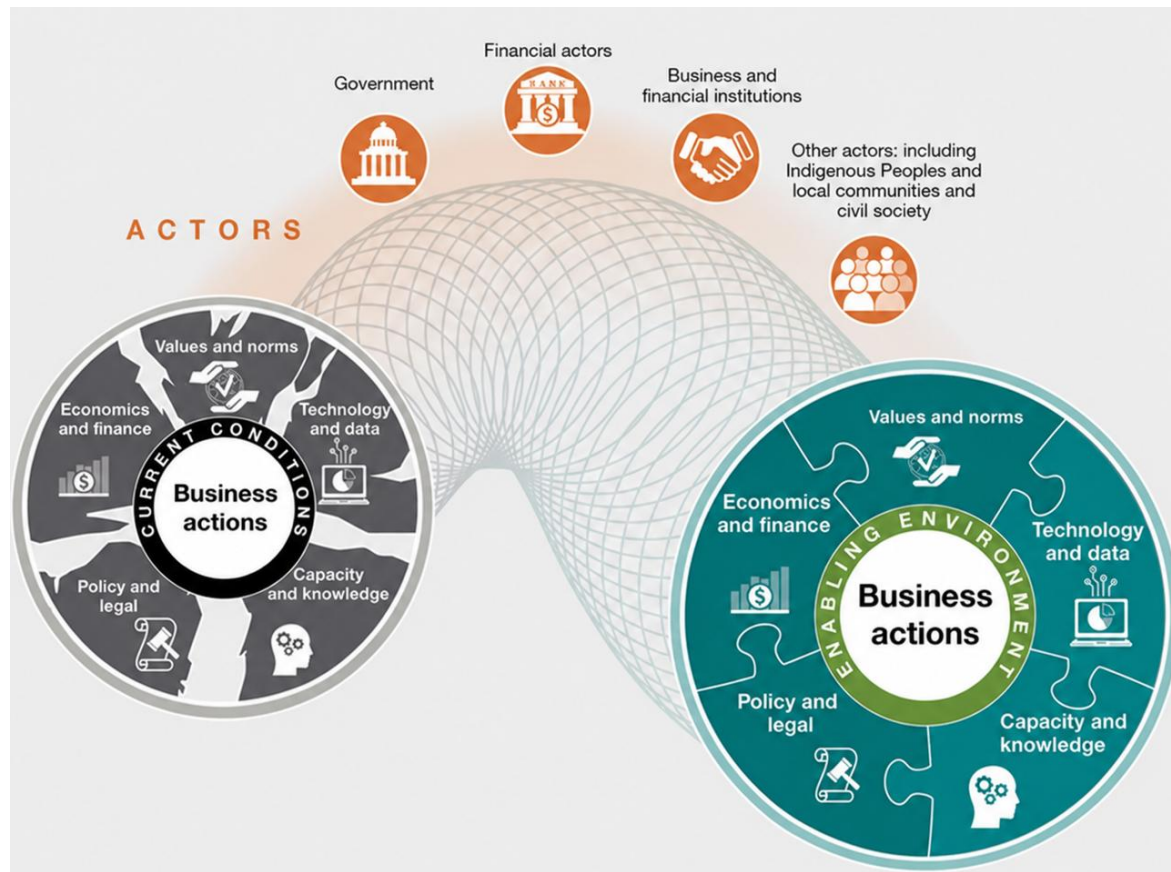

DIFFERENT ACTORS INFLUENCE BUSINESS ACTIONS



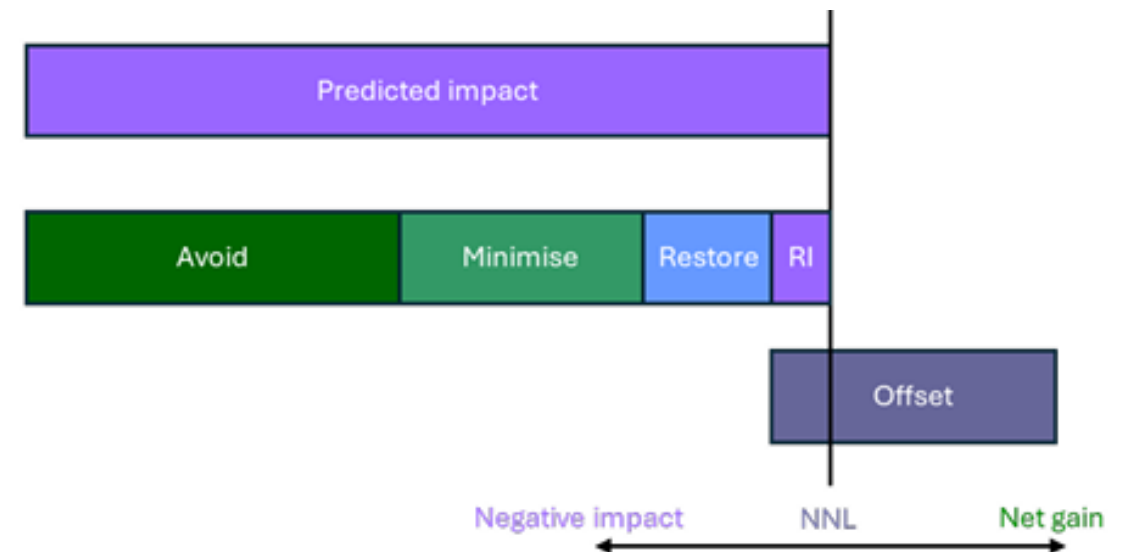

- Systems

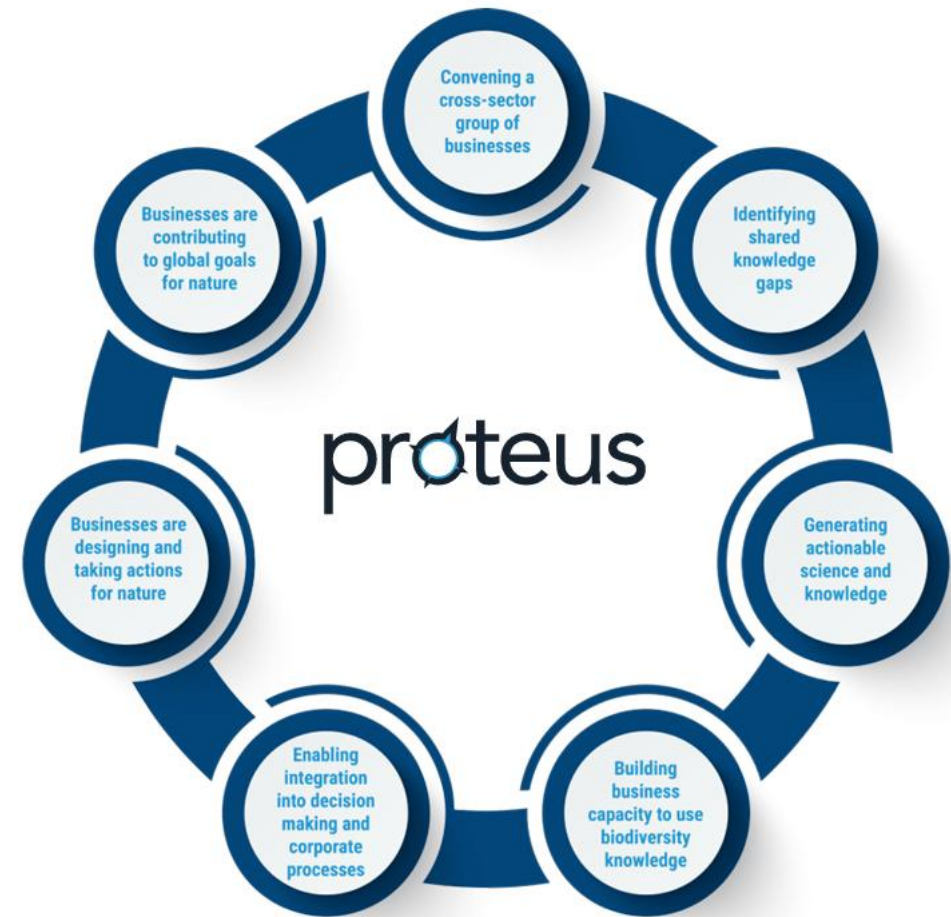
The Mitigation Hierarchy – addressing negative impacts at sites

PROTEUS COMBINES DIFFERENT APPROACHES TO ENABLE ACTION



Goal 1 – Advancing actionable knowledge and evidence for decision-making

Facilitating comprehensive nature assessments

Improvements to knowledge, including solution-oriented research, tools and data, to enable informed business decision-making on biodiversity across operations, value chains and landscapes.

Embedding nature considerations across the business

Materials to help companies communicate the business case for nature throughout their business, recognising that Every Job is a Nature Job.

Navigating global biodiversity policies and processes

Support for companies to engage in global policy events and communication on key developments of relevance to business.



Goal 2 – Enabling implementation in business practices

Building Capacity

Development of internal business capacity through provision of technical support and training to help businesses make use of the tools, data and knowledge that Proteus provides.

Providing intuitive business-focused tools

Access to a top tier IBAT subscription and support in using business-focused tools within different business areas and decision-making contexts.

Convening experts to share best practices
