An expert panel will reveal the two critical components that will make or break the biodiversity agreement: **Adequate finance and ‘30x30’ with the assurance of respect for Indigenous Peoples and local communities**. The 30x30 proposal is currently supported by more than 85 governments worldwide--as well as a group of former government leaders and high-level diplomats who issued a statement in support of the target in advance of the negotiations.
