A Message from H.E. Mr. HUANG Runqiu, Minister of Ecology and Environment of the People's Republic of China on the occasion of

the International Day for Biological Diversity in 2025

Biodiversity is an important foundation for human survival and development. Conserving biodiversity helps maintain our home planet and promote sustainable development for humankind. The theme of this year's International Day for Biological Diversity is "Harmony with nature and sustainable development", which echoes the ancient Chinese wisdom of "harmony between human and nature" and "all things grow together", aiming to promote harmonious coexistence between human and nature and create a path of harmonious and sustainable development.

As one of the countries with the richest biodiversity in the world, China has put biodiversity conservation to the national strategic level, released *China National Biodiversity Strategies and Action Plans (2023-2030)*, implemented major projects for biodiversity conservation, and comprehensively improved biodiversity conservation capacity and management.

As the saying goes, "The going may be tough when one walks alone, but it gets easier when people walk together." China is willing to strengthen exchanges and cooperation with all, work together to address global challenges such as biodiversity loss and climate change, and jointly build a beautiful home planet featuring harmony with nature and sustainable development.
