Written Statement of the People's Republic of China

The International Pollinator Initiative (IPI) consistently focuses on fostering international collaboration, establishes cooperative platforms for global pollinator conservation, and plays a pivotal role in enhancing nations' conservation capacities and advancing sustainable utilization practices.

The Chinese government attaches great importance to pollinator conservation, practicing the philosophy of harmonious coexistence between human beings and nature, and integrating the conservation efforts into the broader framework of ecological civilization construction and China's National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan.
